Application process

1. Contact a PhD supervisor (section “Teaching team” for the list of supervisors) in one of the Universities of Una Europa (Home university)
2. If the PhD project corresponds to Una-Her-Doc requirements the supervisor might recommend a co-supervisor in another Una Europa University (the Host university)
3. Enrollment in the Home university, following this university’s deadlines. After the enrolment to Home university, a bilateral co-supervision agreement
4. the supervisor and co-supervisor will recommend the Doctoral candidate to the Una-Her-Doc Joint Doctoral Committee

2. Letter of Motivation
3. CV
4. Letters of recommendation (supervisor + co-supervisor)
5. Proof of enrolment in the Home university

Certificates

- 1) Double degree issued by the Home and Host universities according to the rules and regulations specified in the bilateral supervision agreement
- 2) Diploma Supplement by the Home and/or by the Host university
- 3) Una-Her-Doc Certificate (template at Annex B) is awarded to Doctoral candidates who have succeeded to the regulations of the Home and Host universities and have met the requirements in line with the regulations of the Una-Her-Doc programme (Annex A)



Language policy

- All the PhD courses are taught in English
- Doctoral candidates can follow courses offered in other languages at the universities in which they have registered
- The PhD thesis can be written and defended in English, in the language of the Host university or of the Home university, with the prior agreement of the Host university.
- A 20-30 pages summary in English must be provided in this case



Quality assurance

- 1) QA annual report to be submitted by each doctoral student in an ad hoc form and to be acknowledged by the supervisors and the Cultural Heritage expert committee
- 2) Independent QA assessment by Each Partner to be submitted to JDC, which will be part of the general quality assessment
