

Isabelle Bosse-Platière is Professor of European Law at the University of Rennes 1 since 2010. She holds a Jean Monnet Chair 'Principles and objectives of external Action of the EU'. She is head of the Centre of European Research (CEDRE) which is part of the Institut de l'Ouest: Droit et Europe (IODE) and member of the direction board of the Centre of Excellence Jean Monnet of Rennes. She is also Member of the Centre for Law of European External Relations (CLEER, La Haye). Her researches focus on the External Relations of the EU in its institutional and judicial dimensions. She wrote many book and articles on these topics. She is co-responsible for two chronicles about the External Relations of the EU in two majors EU Law Reviews (one semestrial in the Revue trimestrielle de droit européen and one annual in the Annuaire du droit de l'Union européenne). She is part of the Key Staff of the LAwTTIP Network.
