

- Committee of at least 3 members (1 UniBo + 2 External)
- Generally on first months of the year

PhD credits: how to get them

University courses

1 hour = 1 PhD credit

PhD courses

1 hour = 1 PhD credit

Master courses

1 hour = 1 PhD credit

Languages (English & Italian)

1 hour = 1 PhD credit - max 40 credits, (courses officially proposed by the PhD board do not contribute to the count) max 30 each

Schools, workshops, seminars (also held online with interactive connections with teachers),

...only those with a final certified test

1 hour = 1 PhD credit

Online courses (i.e. Coursera) max 20 credits can be awarded following the supervisor approval

Internship abroad

10 credits/month, max 60 credits



Credits assignement shall be approved by the PhD Board

The «request of recognition» must be sent to the PhD Office

- You will need to enter all details of the travel, the research funds of your supervisor to be used, dates/times, etc.
- Please describe in an understandable way the motivation of the travel: e.g. don't write "IEEE ICECS 2021" or just "conference" or "meeting" but write "Participation to conference IEEE ICECS 2021 for presentation of a scientific paper". Travels MUST be related to your PhD activity
- Please attach any related document: e.g. Meeting agenda, or Invitation email/letter of research partner, or conference schedule with your presentation, etc.
- Supervisor and PhD coordinator will need to review and approve (or decline)
- When you return, the procedure for refunds is still done online through the website

Travelling > 1 month

a. Before	 Collect the tutor's advice and the invitation letter fill the form of request of authorization send all docs to dei-phd-etit@unibo.it Once authorized:
	1. fill the form (request for the increase of the scholarship) – intranet
	2. send all docs to <u>udottricerca@unibo.it</u>
b. During	 (Option) planning to stay for a longer period? Submit your request to the PhD Board and update AFORM Collect the tutor's judgment + dates of your staying
c. After	1. Submit your credit recognition request - <u>dei-phd-etit@unibo.it</u> - to the PhD Board

Wait for the PhD Board authorization
