Daniel Winterbottom (FASLA) is a Landscape Architect with a Bachelor of Fine Arts from Tufts University and a Master of Landscape Architecture from the Harvard Graduate School of Design. He is Professor of Landscape Architecture at the University of Washington in Seattle (WA, USA), and founder and director of the Therapeutic Garden Design Certificate Program at the same University. His firm, Winterbottom Design Inc., focuses their practice on healing/restorative gardens.

He has developed several programs, including the participatory "design and build" program, where with his students he works with communities to design and build projects that address the social and ecological concerns of the community. He has completed projects in Seattle, New York City, Mexico, Guatemala, Bosnia/Herzegovina, Croatia and Italy.
