

## **CUMULABILITY OF MOBILITY GRANTS. OTHER FORMS OF FUNDING.**

As a general rule, **the 10% reimbursement can be combined with other incentives such as the increase in the scholarship, the Marco Polo scholarship, etc.** Previously, the increase in the PhD scholarship was not compatible with the Marco Polo scholarship. However, for PhD scholarships awarded **under the new regulations** (regular, PNRR, PON), **the Marco Polo scholarship can be combined with the increase in the PhD scholarship for activities abroad**, as provided by current PhD regulations, up to the maximum amount allotted.

In addition to the increase in the scholarship, the Department participates in the extraordinary “**Marco Polo**” funding program. Access to this funding requires participation in a public call for applications, which you can find on the dedicated intranet pages [<https://intranet.unibo.it/ricerca/Pagine/ProgrammaMarcoPolo.aspx>].

The Marco Polo scholarship **is not the only form of extraordinary funding** available for periods abroad. You can also find an up-to-date list of funding opportunities through the intranet:
