## P-GOMAP Forum - 40th cycle

Research activity presentation

**On September 24th (8:45-19:00), 2025**, students of the 40th cycle of the PhD course in Public Governance, Management and Policy, will present progress and any preliminary results of their research during a 'PhD Forum'. Each student will also have the opportunity to receive feedback from a pre-assigned blind discussant. PhD students will have up to 15 minutes to present their research proposal and any preliminary results. The discussant will then have up to 5 minutes for public discussion. Additional comments may be submitted in writing or addressed in future meetings.

After the time allocated to the individual PhD student and the discussant, there will be up to 10 minutes for questions from the audience. All researchers are warmly invited to continue the discussion with the doctoral students on other occasions and/or in one-on-one meetings.

### Guidelines for PhD Students on how to organize their presentation

**PhD students are invited to address the following elements during their presentation:**

- **Description of the research topic** and the specific objectives of the doctoral project, including a clear reference to and emphasis on the connection with the research topic associated with the scholarship.
- **Methodology** to be employed in the research.
- **Project timeline**, including (where applicable) details on data accessibility, and a discussion of the project's feasibility, highlighting any potential risks and proposed solutions.
- **A focused discussion of a specific aspect** of the project, such as a chapter or in-depth analysis of a particular component of the thesis.

Doctoral students are requested to send their presentation slides to the PhD in Public Governance, Management and Policy program at [phd.publicgomap@unibo.it](mailto:phd.publicgomap@unibo.it) no later than September 18th at 5:00 PM. The email should include their supervisor and co-supervisor in copy. The supervisors will then forward the slide deck to the blind discussant prior to the presentation. If the presentation slides are image-heavy and contain minimal explanatory text, the doctoral student is encouraged to also submit a supporting document (not a draft). This document should outline the key points of the presentation and clearly highlight the main connections between them. Student presentations and slides are in English. Express critical and constructive opinions on research objectives, methods, proposed timeline, and feasibility.
