Editing guidelines for the paper to be presented in the frame of the Giornata di Studi

- The paper shall be focused on a specific topic related to your PhD program research to be presented together with the identified discussant during the Final Conference of the first year of the PhD program (“Giornata di Studi”);
- The paper length shall be between 7.000 and 10.000 characters (spaces not included);
- The language of the paper shall be defined in accordance with the identified discussant;
- The paper shall be written using the Times New Roman font, 12 pt, justified;
- Please use the standard structure for scientific paper (Introduction, Methodology, Results, Conclusions);
- During the Conference, you will have 15 minutes to present your paper, then your discussant and supervisor will have respectively 10 and 5 minutes to share their observations with you;
- Please send the final version of the paper to your discussant, supervisor and to phd.global@unibo.it one week before the Giornata di Studi;

A full reference list should be included.

Font: Times New Roman, 10 pt, left aligned, hanging indent 0,5 cm.

For books: Surname, Initials (Year of Publication), Title, Publisher, Place of Publication.

For chapters in edited books: Surname, Initials (Year), “Title”, in Editor’s Name, Initials (Ed.), Title, Publisher, Place, Pages.

Business Theory and Policy, Croom Helm, London, pp. 111-126.

For articles: Surname, Initials (Year), “Title”, Journal Name, Volume, Number, Pages.

Fox, S. (1994), “Empowerment as a catalyst for change: and example from the food industry”, *Supply Chain Management*, Vol. 2, No. 3, pp. 29-33.

Electronic sources should include the URL of the web site at which they may be found along with the date of latest access.
